



BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 37, SERIES OF 2010

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE GUIDELINES FOR THE USE OF BOOSTER PUMPS BY PLARIDEL WATER DISTRICT CONCESSIONNAIRES

WHEREAS, it is the ultimate goal of Plaridel Water District to extend to all citizens, governmental agencies, businesses, and industries within the geographical boundaries of the district the benefits of an abundant supply of safe and potable water at adequate pressure and at reasonable cost;

WHEREAS, PWD Board of Directors and Management, however, acknowledge that due to the high demand of water during peak hours, concessionaires experience low water pressure;

WHEREAS, PWD affirms that its first obligation and responsibility is to those customers now receiving service from the district and that they should not be made to suffer a degradation in the level of water service;

WHEREAS, PWD is doing its best to improve the service with the development of new pumping stations which take some time but will greatly increase water supply and pressure;

WHEREAS, some concessionaires have been found to use booster pumps in their service line to increase water pressure;

WHEREAS, the use of booster pumps is a possible source of contamination and disruption of water supply;

WHEREAS, Management recommended to the Board of Directors the regulation of the use of booster pumps through proper installation which will not adversely affect the water supply in the adjacent areas as shown in the diagram prepared by the Engineering Division;

WHEREAS, Management also recommended the imposition of administrative penalties for concessionaires using booster pumps not complying with the PWD approved installation diagram;


NOW, WHEREFORE, for and in consideration of the premises, on motion duly made and seconded, **BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED**, to approve the recommendation of Management on the proper installation of booster pumps in water service connections of concessionaires as shown in the attached diagram;


RESOLVED FURTHER, that the following guidelines on the use of booster pumps are adopted by PWD:


1. Upon discovery of the use of booster pump in his/her service line not conforming with the approved PWD installation diagram, a customer shall be given a 5-day notice to remove the booster pump or comply with the approved installation;
2. If the customer fails to comply with the said notice, PWD shall be authorized to disconnect the service line;
3. Reconnection can only be made upon presentation of a certification from a PWD inspector that the booster pump has been removed or properly installed together with the payment of the appropriate reconnection fee and administrative penalty of P1,000.00;
4. Upon discovery of the use of booster pump in his/her service line not conforming with the approved PWD installation for the second time, a customer shall be given a 3-day notice to remove said booster pump or comply with the approved installation. Failure to comply will result to disconnection of service. The preceding guideline on reconnection will apply.


RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that PWD will inform its concessionaires and the public in general of this resolution for guidance and compliance.

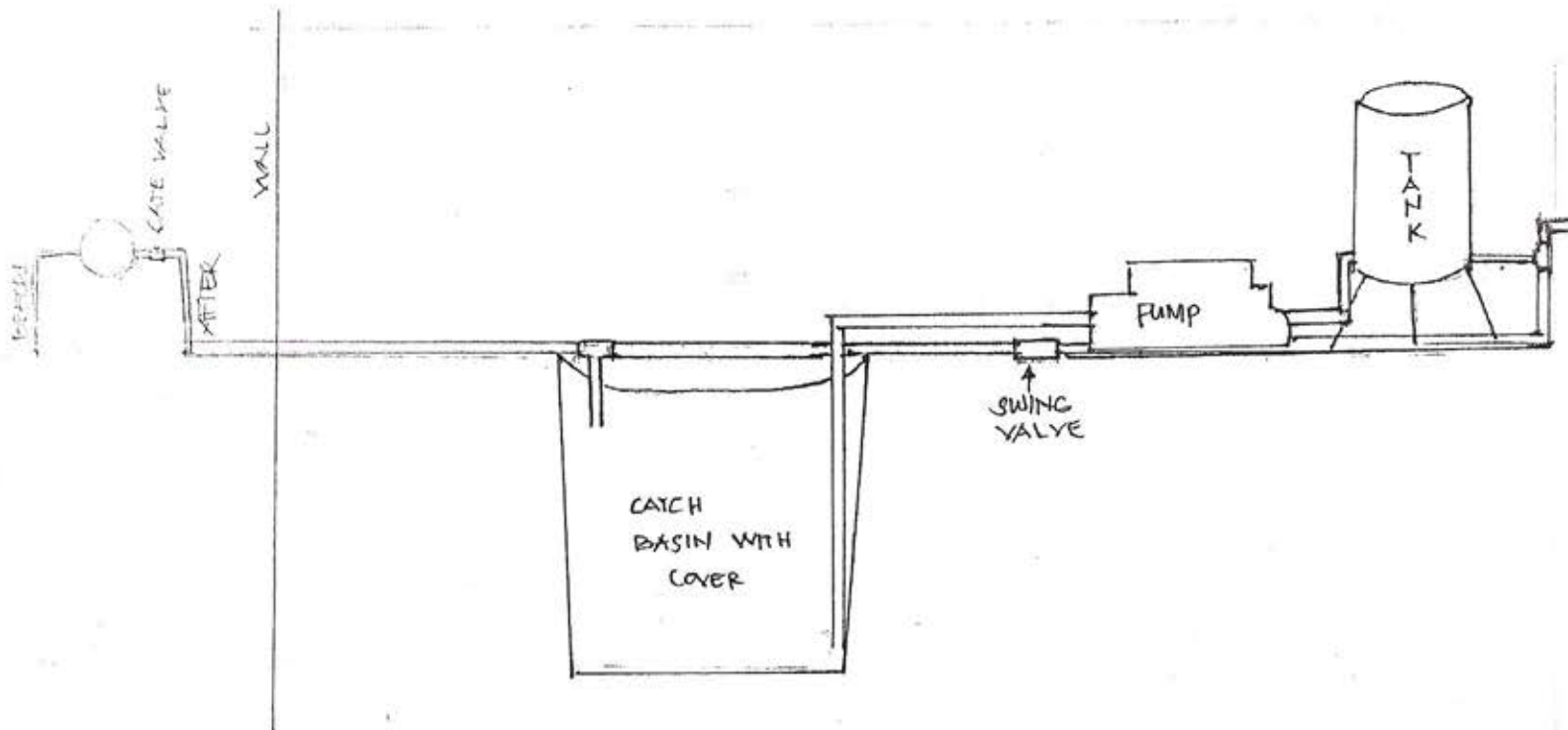
