



EFFECTS OF EL NIÑO

Lesser Rains



There will be lesser rains during El Niño which could impact the country's water supply.



Dry Spell

PAGASA predicts that thirty-six (36) provinces will potentially experience dry spell or below normal rainfall conditions. Mostly in the Ilocos, Cagayan Valley, Central Luzon, Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal, Quezon, Mindoro, Marinduque, Romblon, Palawan, Antique, Guimaras, Iloilo, Leyte, Agusan Del Norte, Dinagat Islands, Surigao del Norte and Surigao Del Sur provinces and Metro Manila.



Drought

The provinces of Camarines Norte and Southern Leyte may experience drought for five consecutive months.

Infectious Disease



The World Health Organization warns that there will be an increase in viral diseases such as dengue, Zika and chikungunya during El Niño



PLAWD ACTION PLAN FOR EL NIÑO PHENOMENON

- Encourage the customers to conserve water and collect rainwater for other purpose/usage i.e, for toilet flushing, watering plants, car washing, etc;
- Practice reduction of water consumption for its intended purpose/use at all levels of the society, in effect reduce water bills;
- Water rationing to areas/barangays with low water pressure particularly during peak hours;
- Coordinate/collaborate with Plaridel-LGU (municipality and barangays), public and private schools and other stakeholders regarding the effect of El Niño phenomenon and the proper conservation of water during this period;
- Strengthen information, education and communication (IEC) campaign on the effect of El Niño phenomenon/drought to the water supply system;
- Monitor/ocular inspection of the water transmission and distribution lines for possible leakages including illegal connections to save water loses and decrease non-revenue water (NRW);
- Closely monitor the pumping operation system as to water discharge and quality of the 8 pump stations;
- Program pipe-laying projects particularly to underserved areas/barangays; and
- Close coordination with the bulk water supply provider especially during this phenomenon.

I-abot lamang ang inyong water bill o billing notice sa Teller, agad nitong i-eencode ang Account Number; susuriin kung akma ang Account Name sa dalang billing notice; hihingin ang halaga ng babayaran at bibigyan ang nagbayad ng opisyal ng resibo na kanyang binayaran. Ang mga sumusunod na tungkulin ay marapat lamang na gampanan ng isang PLAWD Teller:

- a. Tumanggap ng akman halaga ng bayad sa tubig;
- b. Siguraduhin ang Billing Notice kalakip ng opisyal na resibo ay akma sa computer data;
- c. Araw-araw sinusumite ang maghapong koleksyon sa Cash Management Section, Finance Division kalakip ng kabuuang record ng nasabing data;
- d. Sinusuring mabuti na tunay ang mga natatanggap na salapi papel;
- e. Araw-araw ding nagsusumite ng Accountability Reports of Official Receipts sa Cash Management Section.

SMARTER, CLEANER, and STRONGER: THE 1000-PISO POLYMER BANKNOTE

Proper Handling Guidelines

as of 10 June 2022



KEEP THEM FLAT.

Place your polymer banknotes in wallets where they fit properly. If banknotes become crumpled or creased, apply pressure, or flatten them with your hands.



KEEP THEM CLEAN.

Soiled or dirty polymer banknotes may be wiped clean with a damp cloth. Their surface may also be cleaned with alcohol-based sanitizers—just wipe them dry right away using a towel or piece of cloth.



USE YOUR POLYMER BANKNOTES AS PAYMENT FOR GOODS AND SERVICES.

Do not hoard them, nor buy or sell them at a higher price.



DO NOT deface, write on, or mark the banknotes.



DO NOT excessively fold, crease, or crumple polymer banknotes. These could leave permanent fold marks.



DO NOT tear, cut, or poke holes in polymer banknotes.



DO NOT staple polymer banknotes or use rubber bands to keep them together. You may use paper bands instead.



DO NOT damage the clear windows, metallic features, and other security features of the banknotes.



DO NOT expose polymer banknotes to very high temperatures or place them near an open flame.



DO NOT iron them.



DO NOT expose the polymer banknotes to strong or toxic chemicals, such as muriatic acid or bleach.
